Dear Governor Brown:

In support of your decision to dissolve redevelopment agencies and in opposition to Senate Bill 1, (Steinberg/DeSaulnier), which essentially reinstates the power these agencies held, registered California voters have signed a Declaration urging you to veto Senate Bill 1 and any future Bill that seeks to create an "Authority" to manipulate and intimidate local communities for purposes of building redevelopment projects.

There are 711 signatures to this Declaration, crossing all party lines, and gathered within the past few weeks solely by word of mouth.
